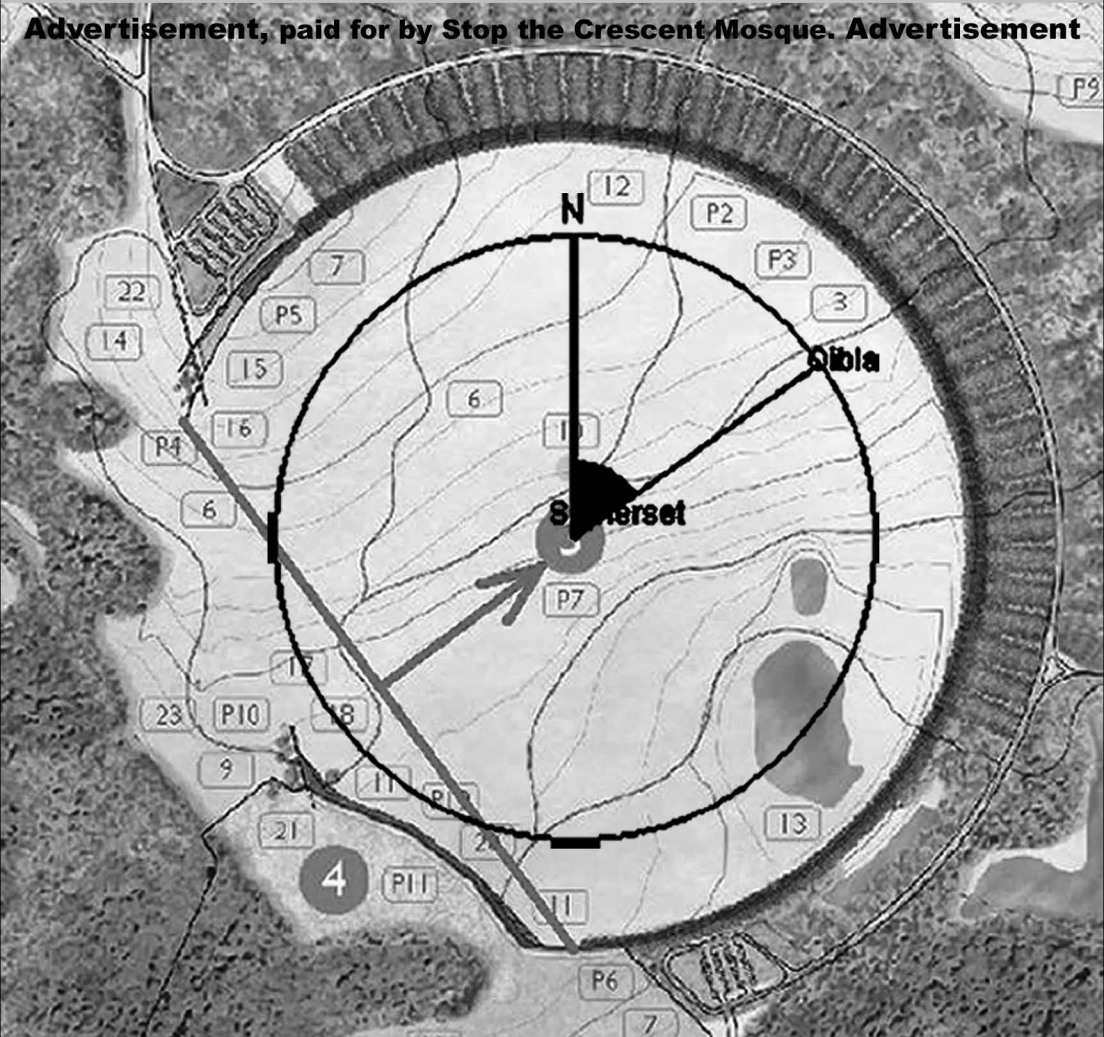


# It points to Mecca

The Crescent of Embrace, with orientation lines superimposed. The giant central crescent of this original design for the Flight 93 Memorial remains completely intact in the Bowl of Embrace redesign. The black circle shows the “qibla” direction—the direction that Muslims face for prayer—for Somerset PA. It was generated by *Islam.com*’s Mecca-direction calculator. A person standing halfway between the tips of the crescent structure and facing into the center of the crescent (arrow) will be facing almost exactly at Mecca. A crescent that Muslims face into to face Mecca is called a “mihrab,” and is the central feature around which every mosque is built.
