

Symbolic damnation of the 40 heroes: Part 1

An Islamic crescent soaring in the sky above the 40 symbolic lives



The Tower of voices is a 93 foot tall tower, formed in the shape of an extruded crescent and cut at an angle at the top, so that its crescent arms reach up into the sky. (Crescent-topped minarets are a common mosque feature in many Islamic countries.)

Literally dangling down below these symbolic Islamic heavens projected in the sky above are forty wind chimes, specifically representing the 40 lives of our murdered heroes.

In Islam there is only Heaven and Hell. When the symbolic souls of our honored dead dangle down below the symbolic Islamic heavens, the logical Islamic interpretation is that they are symbolically damned.
